#### Bursary Information

Presented annually to provide funding to assist critical care nurses to attend a post secondary educational program directly related to the practice, administration, teaching and/or research of critical care nursing.

This bursary is named in honour of a long time member, journal editor, mentor and supporter. This bursary recognizes the contributions of Paula Price, Calgary, AB.

Baccalaureate education or Critical Care Certificate Programs

#### Deadline

June 1

#### Overall Award Criteria

#### Bursary Specific Criteria

The applicant:

1. has the equivalent of one-year (1) of critical care nursing experience in the year leading up to the application;
2. is accepted to a post secondary educational program directly related to the practice, administration, teaching and/or research of critical care nursing;
3. has not been the recipient of this award in the past two years.

## Bursary Submission Process

Applicants are required to:

1. Keep a record of merit points over the past three (3) years – June 1 to May 31 annually;
2. Complete the Education Bursary application and submit with supporting documentation.
3. Provide written confirmation of acceptance / enrolment in the post secondary educational program directly related to the practice, administration, teaching and/or research of critical care nursing
4. Provide a 250-word narrative outlining why you wish to be considered for the bursary and how the bursary will help you meet your goals.

## Where to Submit

1. Online submission at [www.caccn.ca](http://www.caccn.ca);
2. Incomplete nomination packages and packages received after the deadline will not be considered.

## Applicant Selection

1. Applications will be reviewed/scored by the Chair, Partner Relations and the Chief Operating Officer, CACCN;
2. Applicants must have a **minimum of 300** points for the application to be considered;
3. Applicants with the highest number of **verified** points will be the recipient;
4. Applicants will be notified of application results via email and/or regular mail;
5. The successful applicants will be recognized at the Awards Ceremony at the Dynamics of Critical Care Conference (annually in September).

## Additional Information

The Board of Directors reserves the right to amend the criteria as necessary and to withhold the award if no applicant(s) meet the 300-point threshold for consideration;
