Restricted Visitation Study (RN recruitment)

CACCN members are invited to participate in a Modified Delphi Process for a Restricted Visitation Study. Your involvement will include completing an online Modified Delphi Process consensus survey to rank perceptions regarding COVID-19 restricted visitation policies. During the process you will be asked to rank drafted recommendations identified from previous research with ICU patients, family members, and healthcare professionals, and from reviewing visitation policies of hospitals across Canada. You will rank the drafted experiences and recommendations from "not essential" to "essential".

This process will include two to three rounds (depending on consensus) of online polling. Each round is expected to take 30-45 minutes to complete. Your responses would be anonymous and presented in aggregate. The first round is expected to occur from February 1 to 15, 2021. The second round is expected to occur on March 1 to 15, 2021. You will have two weeks to complete each round.
