2022 Certification Initial

Watch for information soon around the new CNA certification system for 2022 initial certification.

2021 Certification Renewal

The new CNA certification system for renewal applications by [continuous learning](#) and inactive status applications has launched.

- Certified nurses that didn't get a chance to renew before the application system closed last October may now renew by continuous learning between **February 19th and April 1st, 2022**.
- Nurses may renew by CL hours with payment of a late fee of \$99.00 plus taxes.
- Nurses may also use the 2021 specialty certification discount voucher until April 1, 2022.

Nurses **due to renew in 2022** can start submitting their certification renewal by continuous learning application as well.

Deadline November 1, 2022.
