Consultation on proposed Agile Regulations and Guidance for the Licensing of Drugs and Medical Devices

Health Canada has recently launched a consultation proposing new targeted provisions and regulatory amendments to the Food and Drug Regulations (FDR) and Medical Devices Regulations (MDR). These will continue to advance the Department's modernization agenda, as well as support the reduction of regulatory irritants and roadblocks to innovation, by making Canada's science-based regulatory system more agile and internationally aligned. The proposal also considers recent experience with regulatory agilities successfully piloted as part of Health Canada's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Health Canada is seeking feedback on both the proposed Regulations and on multiple guidance documents and notices related to this proposal.

The Canadian Medication Incident Reporting and Prevention System (CMIRPS) continues to receive reports from practitioners that describe concerns with labelling and packaging. A multi-incident analysis was conducted to better understand current labelling and packaging vulnerabilities specific to high-alert medications provided in vials and ampoules.
