ISMP collects and analyzes reports of medication errors and other issues so we can learn about the risks related to medications and collaboratively develop strategies to address them. Pharmacy Automatic Refill Programs – Improvements Needed Automatic refill programs are designed to provide patients with continuity of medication supply. This automated process, which is used by many community pharmacies, prompts the pharmacy team to refill long-term medications without requiring the patient to request a refill. Patient experiences shared with SafeMedicationUse.ca have pointed to medication safety concerns with these programs. Read more ...
