Underserviced Chapter Educational Funding Criteria

CACCN Educational Funding

The CACCN Underserviced Chapter Educational Funding will be available to a critical care nurse or a group of critical care nurses in **underserviced areas** (inactive CACCN chapter areas), who develop an activity and/or event that will provide an educational opportunity to **CACCN members** (i.e., education day, webinar, journal club).

Funds Available \$500 – 1,000

(dependent on inactive chapter fund availability and negotiable

based on proposal provided).

Overall Criteria

Criteria

- 1. Potential to increase the visibility of the Canadian Association of Critical Care Nurses (CACCN).
- 2. Potential to increase the visibility of critical care nursing.
- 3. Provision of educational opportunities for CACCN Members in the underserviced area.

Funding requirements

- Proposed event/activity must be held within Canada and within a designated CACCN underserviced area (currently: Ottawa Region, Prince Edward Island, Saskatchewan, Nova Scotia).
- 2. Acknowledgement of CACCN support w/logos must be included on all event flyers, social media, and at the event.

- 3. Event flyers must be shared with CACCN for advertisement purposes.
- 4. Following the event/activity, a report, including an attendee list with emails and permission to contact and the final budget, must be submitted with photographs*, if possible, within 45 days of the event being held
- 5. All submissions become the property of CACCN.

Applicants for funding must:

- 1. be a **current/active** member of the Canadian Association of Critical Care Nurses (CACCN) for a **minimum of one** (1) **year prior to the application.**
- 2. complete the application via the online submission system.
- 3. Include the following information at the time of application:
 - a. a description of the event.
 - b. the number of members who will benefit.
 - c. the number of critical care nurses who will benefit.
 - d. how the funds will be utilized, and
 - e. a simple itemized budget for the event.

The CACCN Board of Directors retains the right to amend the criteria as required.
