Q1 - STEMI Protocol

I am working on a project to implement a STEMI protocol for inpatients. In southern Ontario I have not been able to find a hospital that has an inpatient STEMI protocol. Often it is allocated through Rapid response teams or critical care nursing teams with informal directions on the process. Would anyone have any information around inpatient STEMI protocols in Alberta or elsewhere?

Q2 - Staffing / Step Down Unit

We are working on a Service Design for our Special Care Unit/ Step-Down ICU/ Intermediate Care Unit. As part of this process, we are doing a Jurisdictional Scan on similar units across the country to understand the best practices and issues. One of the aspects we are looking at is the staffing in these units. Would anyone be interested in sharing information around this question?
