BBraun Sharing Expertise Award Criteria	Presented to an individual who exhibits stellar leadership and mentoring abilities in critical care. Award: Conference Tuition, Travel Bursary, Hotel Bursary to a maximum of \$1750
Spacelabs Innovative Project Awards Criteria	Presented to a critical care nurse or group of critical care nurses who develop a project that will enhance their professional development. Awards: 1st Place \$1000 and 2nd Place \$ 500 OR Two Awards: \$750
Brenda Morgan Leadership Excellence Award Criteria	Presented to a critical care nurse who, on a consistent basis demonstrates outstanding performance in leadership in CACCN and critical care. Award: Trophy and \$1000
Canadian Intensive Care Week "Spotlight" Challenge Award Criteria	Presented to a group of critical care nurses who develop an activity and/or event to profile their local Critical Care Team during Canadian Intensive Care Week held annually in October. Bursary: \$500
Criteria Criteria	Presented to a critical care nurse who consistently demonstrates excellence in critical care nursing practice. Award: \$ 1000
Graduate Education Bursary Criteria	Presented to assist critical care nurses to pursue Master's or Doctoral education with a focus on critical care nursing. Bursary: \$1000
Research Grant Grant Criteria	Awarded to a critical care nurse who is the investigator of a research study that is relevant to the practice of critical care nursing. Grant: \$2500
