- Experience with Open Journal Systems (OJS) and/or content management systems
- Some knowledge of current research and practice trends in critical care

Role

- Reports to the co-Editors of IJCC.
- Supervision of editorial team: assigning articles, overseeing publication schedules
- Making decisions, in collaboration with editorial team on submissions
- Oversees the daily activities of the journal
- Overseeing Editing processes: structure, style, copy, proofing
- Support authors writing for the International Journal of Critical Care
- Support authors with methods, manuscript structure and English language and grammar
