# Research Grant Criteria

## **Grant Information**

Awarded annually to the investigator of a research study that is relevant to the practice of critical care nursing.

### **Grant Funding**

\$ 2,500

#### **Deadline**

June 1

#### **Overall Award Criteria**

# **Grant Specific Criteria**

The principal investigator must:

- 1. meet the overall award criteria.
- 2. be a member of CACCN for a minimum of one (1) year.
  - a. Where a student is submitting the research grant application and is ineligible to act as the Principal Investigator, the student must be a member of CACCN for a minimum of one (1) year.
  - b. CACCN members enrolled in a graduate nursing programs may also apply.
- 3. be licensed to practice nursing in Canada.
- 4. be employed by a Canadian healthcare facility or educational institution.
- 5. conduct the research in Canada.
- 6. publish an article related to the research study in the Canadian Journal of Critical Care Nursing™ (CJCCN).

## **Terms and Conditions including Budget and Financial Administration**

- 1. Funds must be used to support research expenses.
- 2. The research is to be initiated within six (6) months of receiving the grant.
- 3. Funds must be used within twelve (12) months from the date of grant provision.
- 4. Changes to the study timelines requires written notification and approval from the Chair, CACCN Partners Committee.
- 5. A final report is to be submitted to the Chair, CACCN Partners Committee within three (3) months of the completion date of the study.
- 6. All publications and presentations arising from the research study must acknowledge CACCN's contribution.
- 7. Within one (1) year of the completion date consideration must be given to one of the following to disseminate the findings of the project:
  - submit a manuscript in accordance with the author guidelines to the CACCN Canadian Journal of Critical Care Nursing™ for review and publication; or
  - submitted an abstract presentation in accordance with the abstract guidelines to the CACCN Canadian Critical Care Nursing Conference; or
  - submit a request to hold a one (1) hour educational event for CACCN members (webinar or journal club).

## **Application Requirements**

The application form requires the following information:

  - d. A brief CV/resume (upload in word or PDF)
- 3. Co-investigator(s):
  - a. Name
  - b. City, Province
  - c. A brief CV/resume (if more than one co-investigator, combine all brief CV/Resumes into one (1) document upload in word or PDF)
- 4. Affiliated Institution/Agency:
  - a. Name. Address and Telephone
  - b. Contact person

- 5. Other facilities and groups involved:
  - a. Name, Address and Telephone
  - b. Contact person
  - c. Type of involvement
- 6. Proposal Summary: Not in excess of five single spaced pages exclusive of appendices (upload in word or PDF)
  - a. Background
  - b. Purpose/Hypothesis/Research Question
  - c. Relevance to Critical Care Nursing
  - d. Method
  - e. Data Analysis Plan
- 7. Appendices: should be limited to essential information, e.g., consent form, instruments. (upload in word of PDF).
- 8. Reference List: APA 7th Ed (upload in word or PDF).
- 9. Proposed Budget: complete the Research Grant Estimated Budget form (upload in word or PDF).
- 10. Funding from other sources: sources of funding and amounts.
- 11. Letter of Support from Sponsoring Agency (hospital, clinical program) or thesis chair / advisor (university / faculty of nursing).
- 12. Letter of Approval from Facility for Commencement of Study (upload in word or PDF).
- 13. Ethics Approval: (upload approval document in word or PDF) OR if not required, provide an explanation as to why.
- 14. Research Grant Agreement of the Terms and Conditions of the grant.

#### **Review Process**

- 1. Applications will be blind reviewed by an Award Review Committee of a minimum of 3, maximum of 5 active CACCN members with research experience for potential contribution to the practice of critical care nursing, feasibility, clarity, and relevance.
- 2. Applicants with the highest rubric score will be the recipient of the grant.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of the application results via email.
