Award Information

This award or awards will be presented to a critical care nurse or a group of critical care nurses who develop a project that will enhance their professional development.

Award Funding

First Place Recipient: \$ 1000.00 Second Place Recipient: \$ 500.00

A discretionary decision by the review committee and Spacelabs Healthcare Canada may be made, for the award to be divided between two (2) equally deserving submissions for the sum of \$750.00 each.

Deadline

June 1

Overall Award Criteria

Award Specific Criteria

- 1. The applicant must meet the Overall Award Criteria
- 2. The applicant must clearly outline the following information the:
 - a. number of nurses who will benefit from the project
 - b. uniqueness of the project
 - c. relevance to critical care nursing
 - d. consistency with current research/evidence
 - e. ethics requirements
 - f. feasibility

- g. timeliness
- h. impact on quality improvement.

Within one (1) year of the completion date consideration must be given to one of the following to disseminate the findings of the project:

- a. submit as a manuscript in accordance with the author guidelines to the CACCN Canadian Journal of Critical Care Nursing™ CJCCN for review and publication consideration; or
- b. submit as an abstract presentation in accordance with the abstract guidelines to the CACCN Canadian Critical Care Nursing Conference; or
- c. submit as a request to hold a one (1) hour educational event for CACCN members (webinar or journal club).

All publications and presentations arising from the research study / project must acknowledge CACCN's contribution

Previous recipients must allow a minimum of one-year lapse between award applications.

Award Submission Process

- 1. Online submission at www.caccn.ca;
- 2. Incomplete nomination packages and packages received after the deadline will not be considered.

Selection Process

- 1. Applications will be reviewed/scored by an Awards Review Committee consisting of not less than three (3) and no more than five (5) active CACCN Members.
- 2. The applications and scoring will be submitted to Spacelabs Healthcare Canada for consideration and approval.
- 3. The Partner Relations Chair will notify the successful applicants via email and/or regular mail.
- 4. The successful applicant(s) will be recognized at the Awards Ceremony at the Canadian Critical Care Conference (annually in Fall).
