CATEGORIES

There are two (2) categories for submission:

NON-RESEARCH

Abstract submissions reviewed in the non-research category do not describe an original piece of research. These submissions may include clinical practice, including optimizing and/or recognizing pre-existing clinical expertise, education, leadership, sustainable practices (environmentally friendly), mentorship, best practices and/or innovative practice changes, and quality improvement.

RESEARCH

Abstract submissions reviewed in the research category include information regarding completed or in progress original research projects.

PRESENTATION TYPES

Abstracts are being accepted for the following presentation types:

- Concurrent
- Skills lab (hand-on learning)
- Posters (printed)
- Posters (oral)
- Other innovative educational presentations.

LANGUAGE

Abstracts may be submitted in English or French.

ABSTRACT REVIEW

All submitted abstracts will be blind, peer-reviewed for relevance, quality, and fit with CACCN's mission/vision and conference educational objectives. Decisions of the Canadian Critical Care Nursing Conference 2026 Review Committee will be final.

PUBLICATION

The Review Committee reserves the right to revise session descriptions and abstracts as required.

Accepted abstracts will be published in the Canadian Journal of Critical Care Nursing™.
