### **Required Qualifications:**

Completion of an accredited nursing education program. Active or eligible for registration and practice permit with the College of Registered Nurses of Alberta (CRNA). Current Basic Cardiac Life Support - Health Care Provider (BCLS-HCP) certification.

### **Additional Required Qualifications:**

Current certification for IV, defibrillation, NRP, and BGM. Minimum one year Emergency Room experience mandatory. Demonstrates ability to work in a highly acute, very busy multi-

disciplinary setting. Must demonstrate organization, prioritization, and critical-thinking skills. Emergency Room experience is a must. The successful applicant will assume unit leadership and charge responsibilities consistent with their level of experience. Evidence of integrity, initiative and sound judgment. Demonstrate commitment to professional development. Ability to function effectively in a team environment. Excellent interpersonal and team communication skills. Must be committed to promoting a positive work environment.

**Preferred Qualifications:**

Preferred ACLS, TNCC, CTAS. Rural Emergency Room and Acute Care experience. Emergency Department experience in a rural setting preferred.
